Program Objective

Program Description: Why Join 'Two Year Foundation'?

- There is a quantum jump in the level of difficulty of subjects for students in Class XI as compared to Class X. The students in any case have to struggle to cope up with Class XI syllabi, add to that IIT-JEE preparation with absolutely no exposure to competitive exams, the job becomes much more daunting. Therefore it is essential that a student develops a strong foundation for IIT-JEE, AIPMT & other Engineering / Medical Entrance Exams. while in Class IX and X only – enabling him / her to perform at an optimum level in class XI / XII as well as IIT-JEE / PMTs.

- At class X level, it is important for a student to score high in X board exams. so as to be able to take admission in science stream in class XI. Rushing past the IX and X classes, without concentrating on fundamentals will neither get good marks in IX & X nor will it lay sound foundation for IIT-JEE, AIPMT & other Engineering / Medical Entrance Exams. So starting entrance preparation after class X will leave you weak in competition as compared to students who study thoroughly for four years i.e. from class IX till class XII.
- Focused study material of Science and Maths in IX & X standards, prepares a student to compete in and preparing for exams. like Olympiads, thereby giving a student the much required exposure to the world of competitive exams, in addition to all the glory they bring along.

Course Highlights

Similarly, while in class X, 6 tests on IIT-JEE pattern and 2 tests on PMT pattern on class X syllabus will also be provided.
- The score of online tests of a student will be clubbed with scores of other students of Aakash, thereby giving students an opportunity to see their simulated rank at an all India* level among students enrolled at Aakash.
- Special material on Vedic Mathematics will also be given to generate interest in mathematics and help them simplify lengthy calculations with greater speed. The vedic mathematics will also help the students in solving tough problems using short cut techniques.

Online Tests for PMTs: Total 75 questions, 25 questions in Physics, 25 in Chemistry & 25 questions in Biology. All multiple choice questions. Each question carries 4 marks. Negative marking: 1/4.

The student should also staple three extra photographs with the form.
